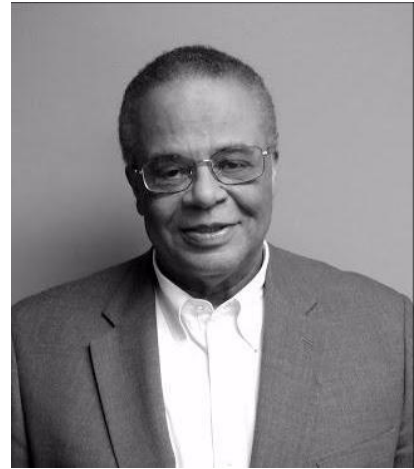


Staff Updates
